Description:

Two coloring sheets designed for a unit on Tzniyus. One sheet reads, “Neshama, Treasured Soul” and features a picture of a diamond in a treasure chest. Use it to bring across the concept of removing attention from one’s body to allow the beauty of the Neshama to shine forth. The other sheet is entitled, “My Royal Wardrobe” and features an empty closet and a mirror. Use it to inculcate students with feelings of dignity and pride in their roles as a B’nos Melech.

Goals/Objectives:

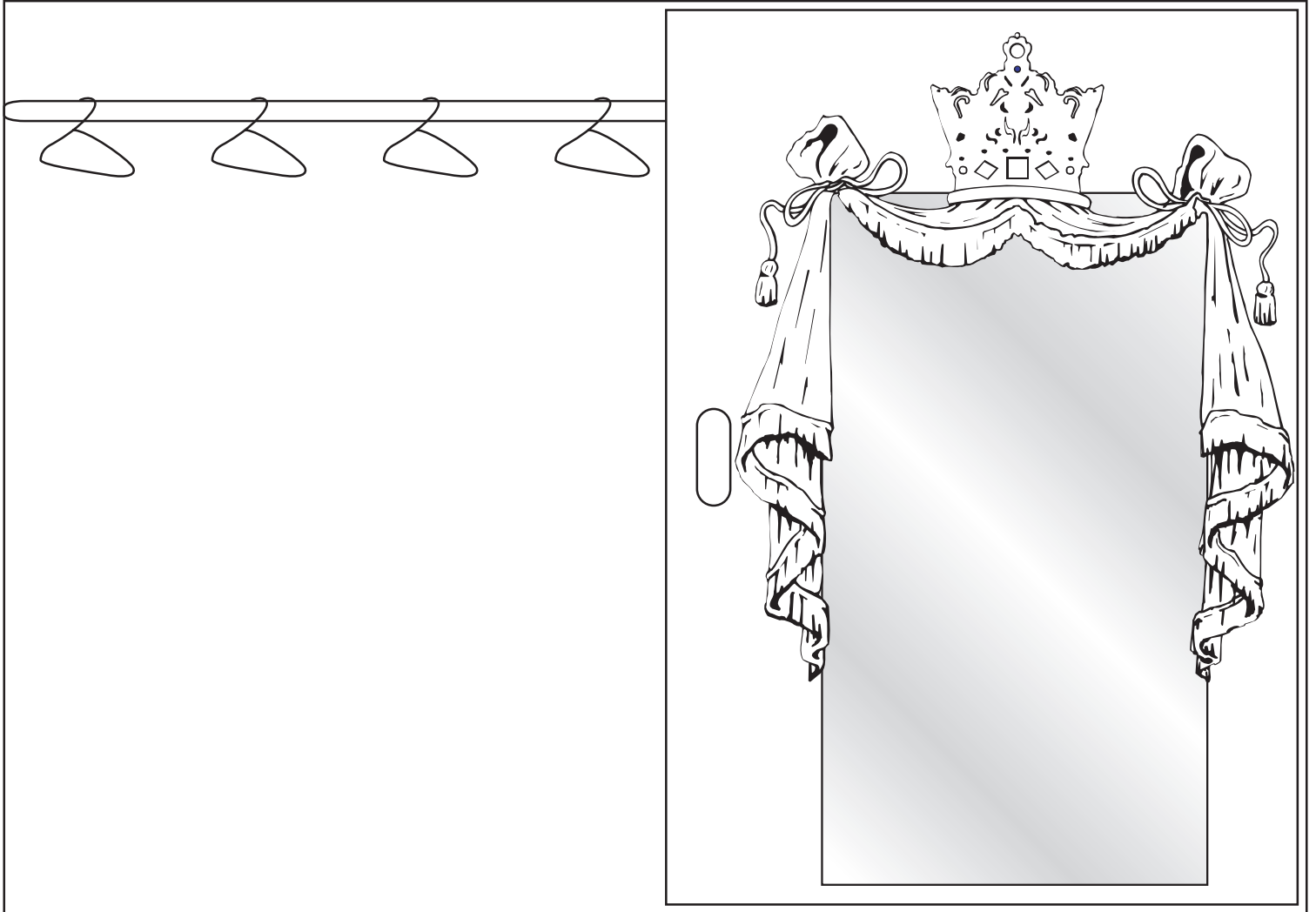
Students will internalize important Hashkafos pertaining to Tzniyus as they color in these sheets.

Instructions:

1. Discuss how the right kinds of clothes help others appreciate our essence (instead of being distracted by externals).
2. Have students color in the Neshama page.
3. Discuss the privilege of being Hashem’s princess and how royalty dresses and behaves.
4. Have students design dignified clothing hanging from the hangers on the closet page. In the mirror, they can draw a picture of themselves wearing noble clothing.



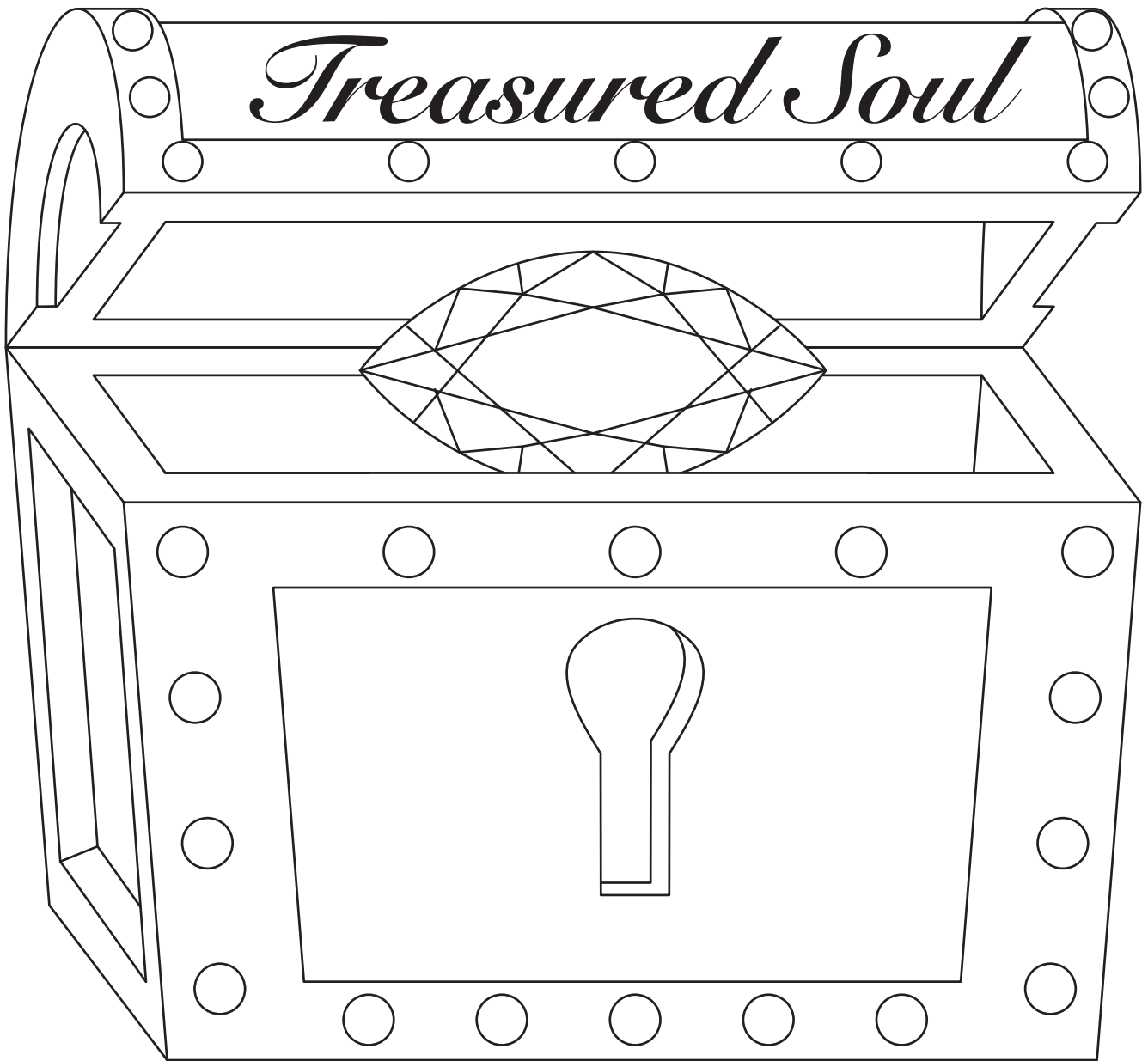
